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### ***Procedure for Animal Release***

- 1) A candidate for release is identified by appropriate WRR personnel as having attained all necessary skills and good health to survive in the wild.
- 2) The landowner/caretaker of a release site with the proper habitat essential for that animal's survival is contacted.
- 3) Details for the release are worked out, such as transportation of the animal, proper time of year, time of day, etc. Any need for supplemental feeding, or other arrangements, are confirmed.
- 4) The animal(s) is/are released; the date and time recorded. Photographs are sometimes taken, depending on the circumstances.
- 5) The landowner/caretaker should contact WRR if there is any sighting or evidence of the animal's whereabouts. If the animal does not appear healthy, WRR should be contacted immediately.
